INSPECTION REPORT

AT : Taldinski coal open cut, Kemerovo region, Russia
ON : 21 May 2014
DESTINATION : Mariyampole
LOADED INTO : 1 rail car

WE HEREBY REPORT that we have performed sampling and analysis of the above mentioned commodity. **QUANTITY: 1 rail car*** with No. listed below with coal of weight (as declared) **67.90 MT** was presented for inspection:

61681821

Note: *as it could be visually ascertained there were lumps of coal up to 400 mm in size.

SAMPLING: Manual sampling as per ISO 18283 5.3. from the top of the rail car: Sampling material in motion, on systematic known mass intervals basis. Samples were taken manually from the above designed rail car, included in the shipment of 30 rail cars. Increments were collected from freshly exposed surface, on a mass interval basis, with fixed increment mass. Manual Sampling method was agreed to with the SGS Principal, as sampling by other methods was not possible.

ANALYSES: Proximate analysis was performed in SGS laboratory (Accreditation Certificate No. POCC RU.0001.21TY38, valid till 22.09.2016) according to ISO Methods with results as follows:

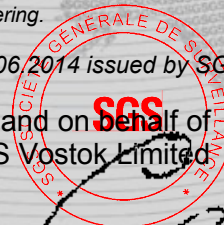
The Nominal Top Size of the consignment was greater than +75 mm, as such it was not possible to sample in accordance with procedures and guidelines stipulated in ISO 18283 Manual Sampling - Hard Coal & Coke for the collection of representative samples. The modified procedure employed by SGS followed the guidelines stipulated in Annex B of the standard, resulting in reduced Precision of sampling.
